
Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's earlier letter of even number, dated 3-4-2023(copy enclosed) and to inform that in partial modification of its earlier O.M. No. 3/(07)PFMS/2023, dated 31-3-2023(copy enclosed), the Department of Expenditure(DoE) vide its O.M., dated 02.05.2023 (copy enclosed) has now issued modified relaxation to facilitate the on-boarding of MPLADS onto CNA platform. Thus, the relaxed pre-requisite for fixing the authorization limit of MPs on new web solution are as under:-

- i. Consolidated Utilization Certificate (Annexure-I)
 - ii. The unspent fund and unsanctioned amount in the old bank account of SA (i.e. MP account at NDA level in this case) are less than 3 crore and 1 crore respectively
 - iii. The duly filled Performa of email, phone number, etc. of the District Authority for creation of user credentials on the new web solution (Annexure-II)
2. All Nodal District authorities are requested to send the above-mentioned documents to the Ministry in original to Room NO. 607, MPLADS Division, 6th floor, Khurshid Lal Bhawan, Janpath, New Delhi-1 and scan copy to can-mplads@mospi.gov.in
3. The SBI officials from the local branch have been requested to also contact you for collection of the above-mentioned documents and you are requested to hand over an original copy of the above mentioned documents to them as well.


In connection with this Ministry's letter of even number dated 31.03.2023 and email sent regarding pre-requisite information for creation of user credentials, following documents are required for fixing the authorization limit of MPs (whose bank balance is less than 1 crore) on new web application.

1. Consolidated Utilization Certificate (Annexure I)
2. Bank Statement of the Nodal District Authorities reflecting the balance less than 1 crore.
3. The duly filled Performa of email, phone number, etc. of the District Authority for creation of user credentials on the new web solution (Annexure II).


OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes – Relaxation sought by Ministry of Statistics & PI (MoSPI) regarding MPLADS Scheme.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Additional Secretary, MoSPI DO letter No. C-65/2019-MPLADS dated 28th March, 2023 on the above mentioned subject. The matter was discussed with officials of MoSPI on 28th March, 2023.

2. The matter has been examined in this Department and following clarifications/relaxations are provided –

- i. With effect from 1st April, 2023, MPLADS scheme shall be implemented in CNA model only as per DoE's guidelines dated March 9, 2022.
 - ii. Relaxation from provision of para 3(xi) and 3(xii) of DoE's guidelines dated 9th March, 2022 regarding return of unspent balances by all the SAs to the CNA account is granted to MPLADS scheme of MoSPI till 31st March, 2024. MoSPI may release funds to the CNA account and issue authorization to incur expenditure to an SA without waiting for that SA to return the unspent funds to the CNA account. However, MoSPI will ensure that unspent funds in old bank account of an SA is less than Rs. 1 crore before issue of new assignment to that SA under CNA system.
 - iii. PFMS division, O/o CGA to ensure that the existing facility to monitor unutilized amount in old bank accounts of MPLADS scheme through EAT module is available to MoSPI after onboarding of the scheme on CNA module.
 - iv. Other conditions stipulated in DoE's OM dated 27th September, 2022 shall be strictly adhered to.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes – Relaxation sought by Ministry of Statistics & PI (MoSPI) regarding MPLADS Scheme.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the meeting held by Finance Secretary & Secretary (Expenditure) with Secretary, MoSPI, AS (PFC-II), DoE and AS (PFS), DoE on 20th April, 2023 regarding the relaxation sought by MoSPI for MPLADS scheme.

2. The revised procedure for flow of funds for Central Sector Schemes came into effect from 1st April, 2022. However, in view of the difficulties faced by MoSPI in implementing the revised procedure, relaxation till 31st march, 2023 was granted to MPLADS scheme of MoSPI from the provisions of DoE's guidelines dated 9th March, 2022. Further, keeping in mind the sensitive nature of the scheme, this Department issued relaxations/guidelines dated 27th September, 2022 and 31st march, 2023 to further facilitate the on boarding of MPLADS scheme onto the CNA platform. A meeting on 20th April, 2023 was held to discuss further relaxation sought by MoSPI for MPLADS scheme.

3. The matter has been examined in this Department and it has been decided that the condition enumerated in para 2(ii) of DoE's guidelines dated 31st march, 2023 that -


“MoSPI will ensure that unspent funds in old bank account of an SA is less than Rs. 1 crore before issue of new assignment to that SA under CNA system”

may be read as

“MoSPI will ensure that both unspent funds and unsanctioned funds in old bank account of an SA are less than Rs. 3 crore and Rs. 1 crore respectively before issue of new assignment to that SA under CNA system”

4. MoSPI should ensure strict compliance of other provisions of DoE's OMs dated 27th September, 2022 and 31st March, 2023.

5. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
