**Subject: Implementation of Revised Procedure for flow of funds under MPLAD Scheme -Integration of mplads.sbi web-application with PFMS – Reg.**


Madam/Sir,

This Ministry in accordance with the instructions issued by Ministry of Finance (MoF), Department of Expenditure (DoE) vide their O.M. No.1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021, dated 09.03.2022 and in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedure approved by DoE vide their O.M. No.3(07)/PFMS/2022, dated 27-9-2022, has implemented the Revised Fund Flow Procedure (Model-2) for MPLAD Scheme w.e.f. 1-4-2023.

2. Para (xiv) under Model 2 of the DoE OM dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 stipulates that “Ministry/ Department will register the CNAs and all SAs on PFMS and use the unique PFMS ID assigned to the CNA and SAs for making all payments to them. Bank accounts of the CNAs, SAs, vendors and other organisations receiving funds will also be mapped in PFMS”.

3. To facilitate the integration of mplads.sbi web-application with PFMS, this Ministry requires PFMS Unique Agency code of all Sub-Agencies (SAs) [State Nodal Authorities, Nodal District Authorities and Implementing District Authorities] under MPLADS.

4. You are, therefore, requested to provide the PFMS Unique Agency code for all Sub-Agencies of your State as per the attached Performa latest by 24.04.2023. This may be considered as top priority.
