## Subject: Implementation of Revised procedure for flow of funds under MPLAD Scheme— regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's earlier letter of even number, dated 14-3-2023 and provisions of para-10.8.1 and 10.8.3 of Revised MPLADS Guidelines,2023 regarding return of all unspent amounts of the MPLADS lying in the accounts of sub-agencies to the Central Nodal Account of the CNA. In order to avoid any disruption in implementation of the Revised Fund Flow Procedure due to complexities of the Scheme, this Ministry had taken-up the matter of return of unspent funds of MPLADS with the Ministry of Finance.

2. Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure(DoE) vide its O.M.No.3(07)/PFMS/2022, dated 31-3-2023 (copy enclosed) has granted relaxation till 31-3-2024 from provision of para-3(xi) and 3(xii) of Guidelines issued by DoE vide its O.M., dated 9-3-2022 regarding return of unspent balances by all the Sub-Agencies(SAs) to the CNA Account, to MPLAD Scheme. Ministry of Finance has further stipulated that MoSPI will ensure that unspent funds in old bank account of an SA is less than Rs.1 crore before issue of new assignment to that SA under CNA System.

3. The instructions issued by this Ministry vide letter of even number, dated 14-3-2023 and para-10.8.1 and 10.8.3 of Revised MPLADS Guidelines, 2023 may be treated as modified to the extent of above relaxation allowed by the Ministry of Finance. 4. All State Nodal Departments are requested to issue necessary orders to all Sub-Agencies (SAs) [State Nodal Authorities, Nodal District Authorities and Implementing District Authorities] in their State/UT accordingly.

5. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes – Relaxation sought by Ministry of Statistics & PI (MoSPI) regarding MPLADS Scheme.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Additional Secretary, MoSPI DO letter No. C-65/2019-MPLADS dated 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 on the above mentioned subject. The matter was discussed with officials of MoSPI on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2023.

2. The matter has been examined in this Department and following clarifications/relaxations are provided –

- i. With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, MPLADS scheme shall be implemented in CNA model only as per DoE's guidelines dated March 9, 2022.
- ii. Relaxation from provision of para 3(xi) and 3(xii) of DoE's guidelines dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 regarding return of unspent balances by all the SAs to the CNA account is granted to MPLADS scheme of MoSPI till 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024. MoSPI may release funds to the CNA account and issue authorization to incur expenditure to an SA without waiting for that SA to return the unspent funds to the CNA account. However, MoSPI will ensure that unspent funds in old bank account of an SA is less than Rs. 1 crore before issue of new assignment to that SA under CNA system.
- iii. PFMS division, O/o CGA to ensure that the existing facility to monitor unutilized amount in old bank accounts of MPLADS scheme through EAT module is available to MoSPI after onboarding of the scheme on CNA module.
- iv. Other conditions stipulated in DoE's OM dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 shall be strictly adhered to.
- 3. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
